



COTYLEDON TOMENTOSA
“BEAR’S PAW”

IDEAL LIGHT

Full sun to partial shade

WINTER HARDINESS

Not frost tolerant - protect from freezing

PROPAGATION METHODS

Cuttings, leaves (difficult), and see

WATER NEEDS

Water only when soil is dry

MATURE SIZE

1 foot tall

ADDITIONAL NOTES

It's easy to see where this shrubby succulent gets its name! The thick, fuzzy leaves have "teeth" at the end, similar to the paws of a bear. When "happily stressed," the leaf tips turn a deep red.

"Bear's Paw" is an adorable succulent that is easy to care for. It does require lots of light, so keep this in mind when planting. It's a great succulent for beginner growers.
