#### •NAVFAC'S LONG RANGE ACQUISITION FORECAST:

\*\*DISCLAIMER\*\* United States Code Title 15, Section 637(A)(12)(C), requires the Department of the Navy to prepare a forecast of expected contract opportunities for the next and succeeding fiscal years and make the forecast available to small businesses. We fulfill this requirement by publishing this Long Range Acquisition Forecast (LRAF) and updating the information on an annual basis. The LRAF contains NAVFAC Indefinite Delivery/Indefinite Quantity requirements that are forecasted for the upcoming and next two fiscal years. The forecast is for informational marketing purposes only. It does not constitute a specific offer or commitment by the Navy to fund, in whole or in part, the opportunities referenced herein. This listing is not all inclusive and is subject to change.

- •NAVFAC Prime Contracts with Large Businesses: Provides a complete list of active contracts with Large Business firms for your subcontracting and supplier opportunities. Each contract is assigned a Small Business Liaison Officer (SBLO) by the contractor. You are encouraged to contact the SBLO directly for inquiries regarding available opportunities.
- •NAVFAC Small Business Contractors: Provides current NAVFAC Contracts with Small Business concerns. The list may be used for various purposes, including market research, subcontract and supplier opportunities, and data collection. Intended users could be Government Contracting Officers, current Government Prime Contractors, potential large and small business subcontractor and supplier firms.
- •NAVFAC Contracts with 8(a) Firms: Current NAVFAC contracts with Small Business Act 8(a) Business Development, Small Disadvantaged Business contractors. The list may be used for various purposes, including market research, subcontract and supplier opportunities, and data collection. Intended users could be Government Contracting Officers, current Government Prime Contractors, potential large and small business subcontractor and supplier firms.
- •NAVSUP Furniture, Fixtures & Equipment Contractors: List of Navy Supply Systems Command (NAVSUP) Blanket Purchase Agreement (BPA) holders for Furniture, Fixtures and Equipment (FF&E). This list is used by all Navy Contracting Officers, clients and contractors for meeting FF&E requirements, including FF&E, specified in Military Construction contracts issued by NAVFAC. For supplier or subcontracting opportunities, small business concerns should contact these firms directly, and/or contact the NAVSUP Small Business point of contact at the following link: https://www.navsup.navy.mil/navsup/business\_opps
- Environmental Contracts: Provides a complete list of active Environmental Contracts with Large Business firms for your subcontracting and supplier opportunities. Included on this list are CLEAN, RAC, and Environmental Multiple Award Contracts. Each contract is assigned a Small Business Liaison Officer (SBLO) by the contractor. You are encouraged to contact the SBLO directly for inquiries regarding available opportunities.
- •Anti-Terrorism Force Protection Contracts: A complete list of the contractors available under the Anti-Terrorism Force Protection Multiple Award Contract (ATFP MAC) for your subcontracting and supplier opportunities. Each contract is assigned a Small Business Liaison Officer (SBLO) by the contractor. You are encouraged to contact the SBLO directly for inquiries regarding available opportunities.
- Navy Marine Corps Intranet Service Provider: Provides the Navy-Marine Corps Intranet Service provider, EDS, Inc., small business program information. Use this information for Information Technology service and equipment subcontracting/supplier opportunities.
- •NAVFAC Information Technology Center OMNIBUS Services: NAVFAC legacy IT systems are hosted and maintained through the NITC, located in Port Hueneme, CA. These services are provided under a multiple-award contract task orders. The three task orders cover the majority of contractor-provided information technology (IT) services for NAVFAC including Enterprise Application Hosting Support, Enterprise Business Systems Support, and Enterprise Operations Support. It does not include standard Navy Marine Corps Intranet (NMCI) network operations and NMCI equipment installation and maintenance. This listing provides contact information these task orders for subcontracting opportunities.

**WILCON Solicitation and Award Forecast:** NAVFAC's Long Range Acquisition Estimating for planned Military Construction (MILCON) projects. This forecast is for advance planning purposes only. Businesses are encouraged to search FEDBIZOPS or NECO for actual solicitations.






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
