



SENECIO HAWORTHII
“COCOON PLANT”

IDEAL LIGHT

Full sun to partial shade

WINTER HARDINESS

Not frost tolerant - protect from freezing

PROPAGATION METHODS

Leaves, stem cuttings

WATER NEEDS

Water only when soil is dry

MATURE SIZE

1 foot tall | 2 feet wide

ADDITIONAL NOTES

This fuzzy succulent can be hard to find, but is wonderful in any arrangement! It has cylindrical, white leaves that look like cocoons. Its leaves grow from woody stems and form little shrubs.

“Cocoon Plant” is easily propagated from its leaves and stem cuttings.

When it blooms, the flowers are yellow.
