


The Social Artist Pathway

Pathway Description

The Social Artist Pathway is a two-period cohort program that blends core social science courses and art courses. The interdisciplinary program is co-taught by Gladys Chaidez (art) and Matt Dale (soc. sci.). Throughout the year, students are responsible for designing and completing major projects, each of which is aligned with the themes standards in both subject areas.

Each year will culminate with an exhibition that is open to the community to showcase outstanding art.

The program is designed to challenge students to develop and unleash their creative skills while finding personal, creative, and social meaning in their learning.



Pathway Courses

Students will take two courses each year of the program. One will be the mandatory A-G social science course, and the other will be the highest art course that they are qualified to take.
