JOB TITLE: LEAD CUSTODIAN

JOB PURPOSE STATEMENT: Under general supervision, to maintain an attractive, sanitary and safe facility; performs custodial and minor maintenance duties in the upkeep of a facility; provides adequate arrangements for meetings, classroom activities and events; minimizes property damage and loss and liability exposure, ensuring that assignments are completed in a safe, proper and timely manner; provides work direction and guidance to others as necessary.

JOB FUNCTIONS:

- Confers with site administration, Maintenance & Operations Supervisor, or Director of Maintenance, Operations & Transportation regarding care and cleaning of the school site
- Coordinates, schedules, and participates in the custodial and maintenance work performed at the school site
- Provides work direction and guidance to custodians at assigned school; assists in the training of custodial personnel and substitutes
- Performs minor repairs and maintenance of a less skilled nature of general electrical, plumbing, painting and carpentry maintenance work on buildings, equipment and furnishings
- Assists in developing work schedules; reviews maintenance reports and work orders.
- Confers with custodial staff regarding work, and the scheduling of activities
- Sweeps, picks up debris, scrubs, dusts and otherwise cleans areas such as offices, hallways, workshops, lavatories, classrooms, cafeterias, libraries, multi-purpose rooms, gymnasiums
- Picks up paper and other debris from school grounds, walkways, and other areas adjacent to the school facilities; sweeps concrete surfaces adjacent to school buildings.
- Performs emergency clean-up resulting from breakage, vandalism, spillage or illness
- Operates a variety of custodial equipment

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JOB FUNCTIONS – continued

- Orders and controls the inventory of custodial and building maintenance materials and supplies
- Inspects building for safety, fire and sanitary hazards for the purpose of minimizing property damage, loss and liability and ensuring safety at work site
- May prepare and maintain a variety of written records and reports
- Assists in moving and arranging furniture, equipment and material
- Maintains a pleasant appearance and demeanor
- Performs other related duties as assigned or needed

KNOWLEDGE AND ABILITIES:

Knowledge of:

- Modern cleaning methods including basic methods of cleaning and preserving floors, carpets, furniture, walls and fixtures
- Cleaning materials, supplies, and equipment
- Safe working methods and procedures

Ability to:

- Schedule and assign work to assigned staff
- Train and provide work direction to assigned crew or site-based custodial staff
- Efficiently and effectively uses and demonstrates cleaning materials, supplies and equipment.
- Understands and carries out oral and written directions
- Inspects facilities for maintenance and repair needs and fire safety and health hazards.
- Establishes and maintains cooperative and effective working relationship with others.

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PHYSICAL ABILITIES:

- Visual ability to read handwritten/typed documents and instructions
- Hearing and speaking to exchange information and provide work direction
- Able to conduct verbal conversation in English
- Able to hear normal range verbal conversation (approximately 60 decibels)
- Able to sit, stand, stoop, kneel, bend, lift (50 pounds), carry (50 pounds), climb, and walk
- Able to sustain manual labor up to 8 hours
- Able to exhibit a full range of motion for shoulder, elbow, back, hip, and knee
- Able to use respirators, for personal protection, as necessary
- Able to work at various elevated heights and in restricted spaces in a safe and effective manner
- Able to demonstrate manual dexterity necessary to perform fine maintenance procedures and operate both manual and power hand tools in a safe and effective manner
