



FENESTRARIA
RHOPALOPHYLLA
“BABY TOES”

IDEAL LIGHT

Prefers full sun but can tolerate shade and indoor growing.

WINTER HARDINESS

Not frost tolerant - protect from freezing

PROPAGATION METHODS

Offsets and seeds

WATER NEEDS

Water only when soil is dry

MATURE SIZE

3 inches tall

ADDITIONAL NOTES

“Baby Toes” has windowed leaves, similar to Lithops. The transparent area at the top of the plant has no green pigment, allowing light to pass through.

In the wild, this “window-leaf” succulent grows under sand with only the tips of its leaves growing above ground. It has white or yellowy flowers that bloom in the Spring or Fall. “Baby Toes” is a favorite for indoor succulent gardens.
