## Australian Masters Squash Championships September 3-14, 2012

South Australia Masters Squash Association (SAMS), Adelaide, will be your host for the Australian Masters Squash Championships in 2012. Our small but dedicated Committee are intent upon continuing the tradition of successful AMSA Championships.

### PLAYING VENUES

The 2012 Championships will be held from **Monday 3rd September to Friday 14<sup>th</sup> September** at

- **South Adelaide Squash Centre**  
2a Midera Avenue, Edwardstown  
(5 courts)
- **West Adelaide Squash Centre**  
139a Henley Beach Road, Mile End  
(5 courts) and
- **Adelaide Malibu Squash Club**  
1 Autumn Avenue, Lockleys (2 courts)

The distance between the two main centres, South Adelaide and West Adelaide, is approximately 8.5 km along Adelaide's primary north/south corridor, South Road. Malibu Squash Club is a short 1 km trip west of West Adelaide.

### FUNCTIONS

Five functions will be held at the South Australian Jockey Club (SAJC) at Morphettville, near Glenelg. Glenelg is approximately 7.8kms (15 mins) from South Adelaide Squash Centre and 12kms (17 mins) from West Adelaide Squash Centre.
