**FORMAT:** Four-Ball Stroke Play competition conducted over 18 holes.

**REGISTRATION:** Players are to report to the cart staging area at **10:45 am** for announcements. Paperwork will be available on the player's cart.

**STARTING TIMES:** This is an **11 am shotgun start**. Starting holes and groupings can be [found here](#).

**FOOD SERVICE:** Lunch will be provided by the MSGA at the conclusion of the round. This is included in your entry fee.

**TIES:** In the event of a tie for the Championship, there will be a hole-by-hole play-off immediately after scores are finalized.

**PRIZES:** The payout will be to 30% of the number of teams entered. The MSGA will offer a cash prize purse to professionals based on the field size. Appropriate prizes will be awarded to the amateur members of such teams. Both winning team members will also receive a trophy.

**DMDS:** The use of distance-measuring devices (DMD) to measure distance only (Rule 4.3) is permitted in this MSGA championship.

**PACE OF PLAY:** It is a condition that player must play without undue delay and in accordance with guidelines established by committee. Guidelines will be distributed upon arrival at the course.

**PRACTICE FACILITIES/RANGE BALLS:** The practice range opens one hour before the first starting time, weather permitting. Range balls will be set up at the practice range and are complimentary for competitors before the round or a play-off. Please allow time to get from the range to No. 1.

**CADDIES:** Caddies are permitted; however, you are responsible for making your own arrangements for a caddie.

**CARTS:** A player and their caddie may ride in a golf cart during a round, but both may not ride at the same time. The cart fee is included in your registration.

**SPECTATOR CARTS:** will not be permitted except for a spectator who can provide an issued and active Handicap Permit.

**CODE OF CONDUCT:** As set forth in the MSGA application, the code of conduct applies to all MSGA Qualifying and Championships.

**PERSONAL APPEARANCE:** Contestants and caddies must be neat in appearance. Blue jeans, designer jeans, t-shirts, and tank tops are prohibited. Shorts must be mid-thigh. Golf shirts with a traditional or mock collar are required. MAPGA Professionals are permitted to wear shorts at this facility.
