| (1) | December 16 (7 a.m.) - 18 (7 a.m.), 2019, for all two-year college prospective student-athletes who intend to enroll midyear:  | Dead Period       |
| (2) | January 13-15, 2020:   | Dead Period       |
| (3) | February 3 (7 a.m.) - 5 (7 a.m.), 2020:  | Dead Period       |
| (e) | March 10 through May 31, 2020 [except for (f) below]:  | Quiet Period      |
| (f) | April 15 through May 31, 2020 [except for (1) below]:  | Evaluation Period |
| (1) | Four weeks (excluding Memorial Day and Sundays) selected at the discretion of the member institution and designated in writing in the office of the director of athletics.   |                   |
| (g) | Authorized coaching staff members may evaluate a high school football all-star game any time of the year, provided the game occurs within the state in which the member institution is located.  |                   |

An evaluation period is that period of time when it is permissible for authorized athletics department staff members to be involved in off-campus activities designed to assess the academic qualifications and playing ability of prospective student-athletes. No in-person, off-campus recruiting contacts shall be made with the prospective student-athlete during an evaluation period.
