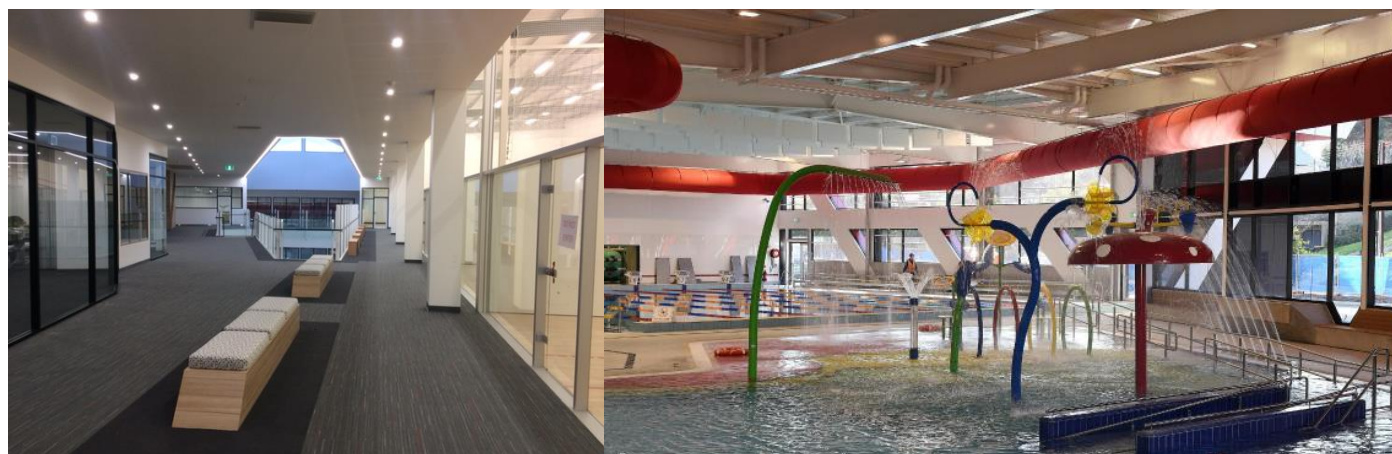
Campbelltown Aquatic & Recreation Centre



The ARC is delighted to be hosting the Sth Australian Racquetball Championships for 2018. This is the second time the state championships have been played at this new centre which was completed in 2016 at a cost of \$26m.

The ARC Campbelltown is a brand-new community leisure hub boasting an impressive range of contemporary sport, fitness, relaxation and function and event facilities in fresh and bright surrounds.

The Campbelltown Leisure Centre boasts spacious change rooms, 5 squash courts with moveable walls, café, clubrooms and a crèche. There is also a gym with weights room, aerobics and dance facilities, and a sauna. The Leisure Centre was completed with a 25 metre lap and splash pool, with furnishings and a dedicated plant room.

Tournament Conditions

- 1) The 2018 Sth Australian Open & Graded Racquetball Championship is a sanctioned Australian Racquetball Tournament Committee (ARTC) event and forms part of the National Grand Prix Tournament Circuit.
- 2) The tournament will be conducted under the Rules of Australian Racquetball dated 1 January 2017.
- 3) Players are guaranteed a minimum of two matches in each event
- 4) Players may enter one Singles event and/or one Doubles event.
- 5) Singles matches will be played on Saturday with Doubles matches to be played on Sunday. If the Singles matches cannot be completed on Saturday, the finals will be held on Sunday morning.
- 6) The Tournament Director reserves the right for the tournament to utilise normal knock-out, swiss system or round robin.
- 7) In Singles – all matches will be best of 3 games. The first two games will be played to 21 points with the third game being played to 11 points (sudden death to 12).
- 8) In Doubles – all matches will be best of 3 games to 15 points. Doubles teams can be two males, two females or mixed.
- 9) Depending on entries, doubles matches will be played on the official Doubles-sized court (approx. 1.2m wider than the standard size). If numbers do not allow, then only the Open event and A Grade will be played on the Doubles-sized court.
- 10) The Tournament Director reserves the right to combine and/or cancel events where necessary, vary or regrade any entry or change the format of any grade where necessary.
- 11) The Tournament Director reserves the right to:
 - a. Refuse or accept any entry
 - b. Suspend or disqualify any player who is deemed to be not playing in the spirit of the game
 - c. Disqualify any player for drinking alcohol in between matches
- 12) Players must arrive at the courts and report to the control desk within 15 mins of their scheduled match time or face possible disqualification.
- 13) Only the endorsed Stellar racquetball ball can be used for ARTC sanctioned events.
- 14) All players are expected to mark and referee a match immediately following their own.
- 15) Protective eyewear that complies with the Squash Australia Eyewear Policy must be worn by all players 19 years and under.
- 16) All players enter the tournament at their own risk.

Presentations to the Singles Champions will be conducted after the completion of matches on Saturday. Presentations for the Doubles Champions will be held after the completion of all matches on Sunday.
