

2017 CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

SECONDARY SCHOOLS SQUASH COMPETITION

OPEN TO ALL SECONDARY SCHOOLS ACROSS VICTORIA

REGIONAL DATES:

Year 11 & 12: Thursday 11th May
Year 9 & 10: Thursday 18th May
Year 7 & 8: Wednesday 24th May
Venues: TBA after entries close.

STATE FINAL DATES:

Year 11 & 12: Thursday 27th July
Year 9 & 10: Thursday 3rd August
Year 7 & 8: Thursday 10th August
Venue: Melbourne Sports & Aquatic Centre (MSAC)
Aughtie Drive, Albert Park.

FORMAT & CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. Each team will comprise 3 players (minimum), separate teams for boys/ girls.
2. School teams will compete in a round robin competition.
3. Matches will consist of 3 rubbers. Each rubber is timed for 15 minutes. Scoring is point-a-rally until time runs out. If the score is level at end of time, a sudden death point will be played to determine the winner. The team with the most amount of rubbers won is the winner of the match.
4. Total **rubbers** won will **determine final placings**. If two or more teams are tied on rubbers won, then the team that has won the most number of games will be declared the winner. If there is still a tie, then the team who has won the most number of points will be declared the winner. If there is still a tie, then the winner of the match between the two tied teams will be declared the winner.
5. Matches will be played in accordance to the Rules of Squash as adopted by the World Squash Federation unless otherwise stated. The rules can be viewed at: www.worldsquash.org.
6. Players will be required to score/ referee the match following their own.
7. Some equipment will be provided.
8. **Protective eyewear that complies with Squash Australia policy is compulsory for all players competing in this competition and must be worn for the duration of all practice and matches.**
9. Competitors must be dressed in their school sports uniform or acceptable squash attire. Non marking soled sports shoes must be worn.
10. Schools may enter as many teams as they wish.
11. Cost is \$60 per team. This covers each team for all rounds of competition, including state finals for qualifying teams. Team withdrawals that occur less than one week prior to the competition will still be required to pay.
12. The competition organisers (Squash & Racquetball Victoria and their officers, employees or agents) shall not be liable for any death or personal injury, loss of or damage to property sustained or incurred by any person in connection with the competition howsoever caused.
13. The competition director reserves the right to;
 - a) accept or refuse any entry
 - b) disqualify or penalise any player/ team for late arrival or misconduct
 - c) combine events
 - d) alter match times
 - e) vary conditions of play
14. School team entries are to be submitted by **Wednesday 12th April, 2017 for ALL sections** (details at bottom).
