

NOTICE TO PLAYERS

LOCAL RULES: Play is governed by the Rules of Golf and its decisions as approved by the USGA and The R&A as of January 1, 2019, and the Local Rules and Conditions of Competitions for GAM Championships. In addition, the following Local Rules shall be in effect:

Format: 18 Holes of Stroke Play Chapman. In Chapman Stroke Play, two competitors play as partners. Each partner plays from the teeing ground and plays the partner's ball for the second shot. After the second shot, partners select their ball with which they wish to score and play that ball alternately to complete the hole. The third shot MUST be played by the partner that DID NOT play the selected ball for the second shot. See the provided sheet for details on penalty or provisional situations.

Tees:

MEN: Oakhurst White Tee Markers WOMEN: Oakhurst Red Tee Markers

DISREGARD ALL COURSE BALL DROPS!!

Handicap Procedure: Each player's Handicap Index will be applied to the Handicap Table for the tees to be played. The team handicap will be determined as follows: the partner with the lower Course Handicap is allowed 60 percent of his/her Course Handicap, and the partner with the higher Course Handicap is allowed 40 percent of his/her Course Handicap. Per the World Handicap System recommendations, no adjustments will be made based on the difference in course handicaps of teammates.

<u>Out of Bounds</u>: Defined by the inside edge of white stakes or the inside edge of the road.

<u>Ground Under Repair</u>: All freshly-painted white lined areas. Newly-laid sod and flower beds are Ground Under Repair and a No Play Zones. You must take relief for any interference of lie, stance, or swing.

Obstructions: Wooden planks and support walls in bunkers are immovable obstructions.

<u>Integral Parts of the Course</u>: The rock walls and piles are integral parts of the course. There is no relief without penalty.

<u>Playoff:</u> In case of a tie for the Championship, a three-hole net aggregate playoff will begin immediately after the final scores have been posted.

<u>Distance Measuring Devices:</u> The following Rule applies to players, as well as caddies, in the competition, if a player uses a distance-measuring device that is designed to gauge or measure other conditions that might affect his/her play, AND USES IT FOR THOSE OTHER CONDITIONS the player is in breach of Rule 4. 3a(1) and subject to the general penalty. If the player then continues to use the device, the player is subject to disqualification.

<u>Pace of Play:</u> Please refer to the local pace of play policy. Keep within 13 minutes of the group ahead of you and you are expected to make a stroke in no more that 40 seconds from when you are able to play without interference or distraction. You should usually be able to play more quickly than that and are encouraged to do so.

Remember:

- The GAM may time all players at any point
- Always play ready golf
- Your position relative to the group in front of you is your responsibility.
