Washing Hands Lesson

Lesson: Washing Your Hands

Learning Objectives:

Students will learn the correct way to wash their hands and be able to demonstrate it on a daily basis.

Materials & Preparation:

- Washing Hands power point (included)
- Sequencing activity (multiple levels included) minimized to 10 steps
- Comprehension questions (included)
- Sink, soap, paper towels

Instruction:

- Show the power point for How to Wash Your Hands
- Go over why it's important to wash your hands and keep them clean

Full Class Activity:

- Go over steps for washing hands as a class
- Model washing hands
- Have students demonstrate washing their hands. Support as needed and go through explaining each step with each student.

Independent Working Time:

- Have students complete the sequence the steps for washing hands.
 Encourage them to remember what they just did!
- Comprehension questions

Wrap up/Closing:

- Why is it important to wash our hands?
- When do we wash our hands?
- Who can remember the steps for washing hands?

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Other Ideas for Activities:

- Tell students you need help remembering steps for washing hands. Have them walk you through washing your hands. You do exactly what they say (even if it's wrong), then teach what's right!
- Put glitter, flour, shaving cream etc. to make student's hands dirty. Have them practice and demonstrate how well you should scrub your hands.
- For our younger learners, teach them a song to sing while washing hands to make sure they scrub their hands long enough.
- Explain how far germs can spread when people sneeze, (researchers say 19-26 feet!!!!), and how many germs can accumulate on our hands and everywhere. Stress that washing hands can even help you not get sick!
