#### **FORMAT:**

54-Holes | Stroke Play This event will be a counting event for WAGR

**REGISTRATION:** Players are to report to their assigned starting tees, ready to play, 10 minutes before their starting time. **There will be no formal check-in or call to the tee**.

### **FORMAT & STARTING TIMES:**

**Monday** | Tee times will begin at 7:30 am off No. 1 & No. 10. The field will be cut to the low 30 players + Ties

**Tuesday** | Tee times will begin at 7:30 am off of No. 1. There will be a re-pair between the Second and Third Rounds. Lunch will be provided to players on Tuesday.

\*\*Note: The Committee reserves the right to not re-pair between the Second and Third Rounds. \*\*

First Round starting times & groupings can be FOUND HERE.

**TIES:** In the event of a tie for the Championship, there will be a hole-by-hole play-off immediately after scores are finalized.

**PRIZES:** The Champion will receive a trophy and appropriate prizes will be awarded to players.

**DMDS:** The use of distance-measuring devices (DMD) to measure distance only (Rule 4.3) is permitted in this MSGA championship.

**PACE OF PLAY**: It is a condition that player must play without undue delay and in accordance with guidelines established by committee. Guidelines will be distributed upon arrival at the course.

**PRACTICE ROUNDS:** Practice Rounds Will be available weekday afternoons and Saturday/Sunday AFTER 2 pm. Players can contact the club directly at (410) 747-5196. The practice round fee will be \$55 payable by credit card. Please do not just show up to the course.

**PRACTICE FACILITIES/RANGE BALLS:** There is no full range at Rolling Road Golf Club. There is a hitting mat/net as well as the short game facility for chipping; please plan accordingly.

**CADDIES:** Caddies are permitted; however, you are responsible for making your own arrangements for a caddie.

**PLAYER & SPECTATOR CARTS:** Automotive transportation is permitted for players and caddies. Carts are included in the entry fee. A player and his caddie may ride in a golf cart during a round, but both may not ride at the same time. **Spectator Carts** will not be permitted except for a spectator who can provide an issued and active Handicap Permit.

**CODE OF CONDUCT:** As set forth in the MSGA application, the <u>code of conduct</u> applies to all MSGA Qualifying and Championships.

**PERSONAL APPEARANCE:** Contestants and caddies must be neat in appearance. Blue jeans, designer jeans, t-shirts, and take tops are prohibited. Shorts must be mid-thigh. Golf shirts with a traditional or mock collar are required.
