Do I need to upload to all of the vendors and distributors you talk about in this course?

No. Stay tuned to the pluses and minuses for each one, so you can make the best determination for yourself.

Do I need to be a business to open up accounts?

No, you don't. There is an "Individual" option for each vendor and distributor.

How early do I need to open these vendor accounts before I publish my book?

I recommend at least 5 business days, in case there is any hiccups to sort out before you want to upload your book.
