Moien!

Welcome to this first lesson of Easy Luxembourgish 1. In this lesson you'll learn how to say "hello" and "goodbye", and you'll also learn to say "yes" and "no".

Ready to begin?

I begin by asking you this question:

Bass du prett?

Are you ready?

In answer to this question, you can say "yes" or "no".

Jo

yes

Nee

no

To say "yes, I'm ready", you can say , **jo ech sinn prett. Ech sinn** meaning "I am". We'll cover this in more detail in the future.'

Saying "Hello" and "Goodbye"

Let's learn some greetings:

Moien

hello

gudde Moien

good morning

Moien, meaning “morning” is used throughout the day until 17h00 and 18h00 o’clock. **Gudde Moien** is commonly used to greet someone in the morning.

Friends and young people greet each other by saying:

Salut

hello (informal)

We will learn more greetings for different times of the day in the next lesson.

Äddi

goodbye

Awar

goodbye (formal)

If you are going to be seeing someone the next day you can say:

bis muer

until tomorrow

The word **muer** means tomorrow, as in **bis muer**. However, **Moien** means morning. So:
