2018-19 Junior Activities Requirement Contract

Junior year is a year of transitioning from adolescence to adulthood. It requires a mature demeanor and good decision making. Additionally, juniors are role models on campus; therefore, they are responsible for their actions. Participation in Perris High School's activities is a privilege. Field trips, dances (i.e. Homecoming, Winter Formal, Prom, etc.), are activities that require positive, responsible, and respectful behavior and good attendance. If a student fails to have a positive impact on the campus, Perris High administration reserves the right to revoke the privilege to these activities.

- 1.) Juniors who do not maintain acceptable school attendance may not participate in school activities. Juniors must have:
 - a.) Less than 64 periods of unverified period absences.
 - b.) Less than 64 tardies to class and unverified period absences.
- 2.) Juniors who receive a qualifying referral may not be eligible to participate in school activities.
 - a.) First, low-level referral may require a parent conference/discussion. The student's name may be added to the non-participation list for one activity and the student may be excluded from additional school activities. Student may attend Saturday School, Lunch Intervention, or after-school Campus Beautification to earn the privilege to attend school activities again.
 - b.) Second, low-level referral or first suspendable offense, demonstrates a clear violation of this contract and the student may not be allowed to participate in any school activities. Students may appeal the decision in writing to the administrative cabinet for review. Students may attend Saturday School, Lunch Intervention, or after-school Campus Beautification to earn the privilege to attend school activities again.
- 3.) If a student is removed from a school activity for violation of this contract, no monies/fees paid in advance, will be refunded.
- 4.) Failure to be current on the required number of credits for senior year could affect senior activity participation, so passing classes and getting caught up on credits is of the highest importance.

All signatures below constitute an agreement to the terms of this contract. Forgery of this contract, or signatures herein, constitutes immediate removal from school activities listed above. The consequences outlined in this contract will be enforced regardless if student/parent provide signatures.
