


Dual Enrollment





Program Description

- Paloma Valley High School has developed a relationship with our neighbor, Mount San Jacinto Junior College (MSJC), to allow high school students to receive college and high school credit simultaneously. Qualified teaching staff are recognized by both institutions and provide advanced classes for those who qualify and are interested.
- Qualifications for admission into these classes:
 - Must be 16
 - Must have a 3.0 in core classes.
- Courses are free (\$6 fee) and held during the normal school day. In addition to saving time and money, students participating in the Dual Enrollment program will have an easier transition to college and will be more prepared for the rigors of college level studies once they are finished with high school.
