The snowstorm was expected to drop 16 inches of snow on New York on Tuesday, a prediction that has closed schools, libraries, and some subways. Despite the fact that it's been downgraded, plenty of people still aren't working or are working from home, but if you're planning to venture out for food or drink, check first — many restaurants are closing in light of the weather. Those who do venture out might be treated to discounts and specials.

Snow Day Deals

- Midtown American restaurant Atwood Kitchen and Bar and Gramercy restaurant Shay and
 Ivy will be offering half of bottles of house wine and mac and cheese.
- Lower East Side bar Rochelle's will be offering all-night happy hour and \$5 shots of Fireball starting at 4:00 p.m.
- Murray Hill restaurant RARE Bar & Grill is open, and if you say "Back That Snow Up" to your server, you'll get 10 percent off their flambéed burgers.
- Gramercy Tavern is waiving its corkage fee during lunch service.
- The Vine inside the Eventi Hotel is offering complimentary hot chocolate with every purchase.
- This from **The Modern**, Danny Meyer's restaurant inside the MoMA: We'll be open in the Bar Room for lunch today and offering a special tasting menu, \$128 for 6 courses. We're also waiving corkage fees today, so bring in your favorite bottle of wine and warm up with us. Stay tuned this afternoon for updates on dinner.
- Harold's Meat + Three (2 Renwick St.) will become a meat + four today, with chef Harold Moore offering a complimentary additional side with any entree, as well as biscuits and a dessert of choice. Additionally, the restaurant will be offering its Taco Tuesday special: Free tacos with purchase of every cocktail, beer or glass of wine from 5:00 to 7:00 p.m.
