New Yorkers, prepare to get your grub on.

Bon Appétit magazine's first-ever Grub Crawl hits Brooklyn this weekend, with a chance to sip and savor throughout the borough.

The crawl will then hit New Orleans and Los Angeles in the coming weeks.

"We chose Brooklyn, New Orleans and Los Angeles

because they are some of the most dynamic and innovative food communities in the country," says Bon Appétit vice president and publisher Pamela Drucker Mann.

The tour will snake through Carroll Gardens on Friday, Williamsburg on Saturday and Red Hook on Sunday. It will culminate with a concert at the Knitting Factory, featuring local favorite Wake! Wake!

Stops include Seersucker, where guests will get to experience Southern fare and

libations from chef-owner Robert Newton. The menu includes a seasonal vegetable amuse bouche, fried chicken and biscuits with homemade spreads, and sips of local New York State wines.

At famous Brooklyn deli Mile End, grub crawlers will try meats and pickles with chef-owner Noah Bernamoff.

At the Brooklyn Winery, participants will go on a behind-the-scenes tour and taste soon-to-be-released spring wines.

Other stops include the

Clover Club, the Meatball Shop, Allswell, Maison Premiere, Rye and Sunny's.

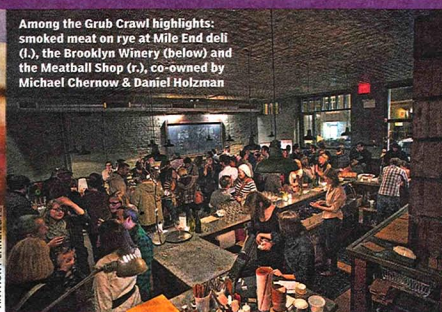
YOU SHOULD KNOW

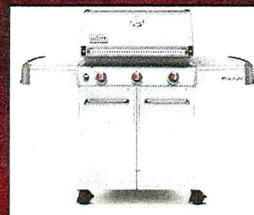
