KIDS MUSEUM PASSPORTS

What museums can I get passes for?

Unless otherwise noted:

The Kids Museum Passport allows a family of four general admission during regular hours.
A group must include at least one child under 18 for the pass to be valid.
A maximum of two adults are admitted with each pass.

Passes are available for 15 museums. Click the museum name to see if a pass is available to check out:

- Adler Planetarium
- Art Institute of Chicago
- Brookfield Zoo
- Chicago Botanic Garden: 50 percent off parking for one vehicle (car level only) with one child and a maximum of three adults; admission is always free
- Chicago Children’s Museum: A group does not need to include a child for this pass to be valid.
- Chicago History Museum
- DuSable Museum of African American History
- The Field Museum
- Institute of Puerto Rican Arts & Culture: VIP admission for a family of four to all museum exhibitions, one guided tour (advance reservation must be made) and a 10 percent discount at the museum store; admission is always free
- Lincoln Park Zoo: 10 percent discount on food and retail purchases for a family of four; admission is always free
- Museum of Contemporary Art
- Museum of Science and Industry
- National Museum of Mexican Art: VIP admission for up to four people of any age to all museum exhibition previews, one guided tour (advance reservation must be made) and a 20 percent discount at the museum store; admission is always free
- The Peggy Notebaert Nature Museum
- Shedd Aquarium
