



KALANCHOE PUMILA
“FLOWER DUST PLANT”

IDEAL LIGHT

Prefers full sun but can tolerate shade and indoor growing.

WINTER HARDINESS

Not frost tolerant - protect from freezing

PROPAGATION METHODS

Stem cuttings and leaves

WATER NEEDS

Water only when soil is dry

MATURE SIZE

12 inches tall | 3 feet wide

ADDITIONAL NOTES

“Flower Dust Plant” is a silver succulent that forms a small, clumping bush. Its oblong leaves are covered in white, waxy hairs that give it a “dusty” look. Small pink flowers bloom in the Spring.

Kalanchoe pumila is a great addition to rock gardens or hanging baskets. As it grows, it spreads out as a small shrub. It is native to Madagascar.
