



ECHEVERIA IMBRICATA
“BLUE ROSE”

IDEAL LIGHT

Partial sun to partial shade

WINTER HARDINESS

Not frost tolerant - protect from freezing

PROPAGATION METHODS

Leaves or offsets

WATER NEEDS

Water only when soil is dry

MATURE SIZE

8 inches tall | 6 inches wide

ADDITIONAL NOTES

“Blue Rose” is one of the most common Echeverias. Its large, flat leaves are a powder blue color, with pink around the edges.

As the plant gets older, it begins to form clusters of rosettes. The older leaves towards the bottom of the stem dry up, with healthy, newer leaves forming at the top. The leaves are covered by a powder, protecting the succulent from sun damage.
