Visiting Coach and Mentor Policy – SSA049

This policy covers situations where a Coach; Player Mentor; or Specialist is 'visiting' a Squash SA Program/Tournament and is engaged by Squash SA on an Honorarium or Volunteer basis.

Visiting is defined as a Coach; Player Mentor; or Specialist whom may or may not hold official professional accreditation and does not reside in South Australia and is therefore not a member of the Squash SA Performance Pathways Approved Coaching Pool.

Conditions under which the Coach/Mentor MUST adhere to:

- Coach; Player Mentor; or Specialist must be supervised at all times by an accredited and approved Coach/Employee of Squash SA.
- The Coach; Player Mentor; or Specialist is to NEVER be alone with participants in a Squash SA Program/Event.
- In Lieu of a 'National Police Certificate,' the Coach; Player Mentor; or Specialist must provide a written reference from a person who has known or worked with them for more than 12 months.
- Squash SA will negotiate and Honorarium payment directly with the Coach; Player Mentor; or Specialist.
- Where the Coach; Player Mentor; or Specialist has an official accreditation, every effort must be made to provide Squash SA with a Copy prior to commencement of the Program/Event.
