“PORK AND BEANS”

IDEAL LIGHT

Full sun

WINTER HARDINESS

Not frost tolerant - protect from freezing

PROPAGATION METHODS

Cuttings and leaves

WATER NEEDS

Water only when soil is dry

MATURE SIZE

12 inches tall

ADDITIONAL NOTES

Sedum rubrotinctum “Pork and Beans” is a fun succulent with round, bean-like leaves whose tips turn a deep red when in full sun. It has a woody stem and displays yellow flowers in the Spring.

It's very popular among succulent lovers, and quite easily propagated. It is not uncommon for *Sedum rubrotinctum* to “drop leaves,” and propagate new plants from the fallen leaves.
