

SEDUM RUBROTINCTUM "PORK AND BEANS"

IDEAL LIGHT

Full sun

WINTER HARDINESS

Not frost tolerant - protect from freezing

PROPAGATION METHODS

Cuttings and leaves

WATER NEEDS

Water only when soil is dry

MATURE SIZE

12 inches tall

ADDITIONAL NOTES

Sedum rubrotinctum "Pork and Beans" is a fun succulent with round, bean-like leaves whose tips turn a deep red when in full sun. It has a woody stem and displays yellow flowers in the Spring.

It's very popular among succulent lovers, and quite easily propagated. It is not uncommon for Sedum rubrotinctum to "drop leaves," and propagate new plants from the fallen leaves.
