The Vice President for Advancement and University Relations will be responsible for all strategic and operational planning for Advancement and University Relations; the development and management of systems of accountability for the staff in all divisional areas; management of budget priorities; and representation of the division internally and externally. The Vice President will oversee major gifts, planned gifts, corporation and foundation relations, alumni relations and annual giving as well as compliance with CASE standards, working with the RU Foundation, university wide branding, messaging, marketing, advertising, public and media relations, publications, creative services, and digital and media strategy.

Radford University is a comprehensive public university of nearly 9,000 students located in the foothills of Virginia. It is nationally recognized for many of its undergraduate and graduate programs, as well as its sustainability initiatives. Known for its strong faculty and student bonds, innovative use of technology in the learning environment, and vibrant student life, Radford University offers students many opportunities to get involved and succeed in and out of the classroom. The university offers 76 bachelor's degrees in 47 disciplines, three associate degrees, and six certificates at the undergraduate level; 28 master's programs in 23 disciplines and six doctoral programs at the graduate level; and 13 post-baccalaureate certificates and one post-master's certificate. As a Division I member of the NCAA and Big South Conference, Radford University competes in 16 men's and women's varsity athletics. It offers numerous opportunities for student engagement, leadership development, and community service through more than 300 clubs and organizations. In addition to the wealth of academic and engagement offerings on the beautiful 211-acre main campus in Radford, Virginia, Radford University also offers a clinical-based educational experience for more than 1,100 students in Roanoke, Virginia as part of Radford University Carilion, a public-private partnership focused on cutting-edge delivery of health sciences programming, outreach, and service. With an eye on the future, the university is in the midst of a \$100 million campaign that focuses on five pillars: access and opportunity; academic excellence and research; student success and engagement; the athletic experience; and emerging needs. With the help of more than 80,000 alumni worldwide, Radford University is confident in meeting the goal and ensuring continued impact for students, faculty, staff, the community, the Commonwealth of Virginia, the nation, and the world.

The Business School received recognition from The Princeton Review among best business schools and best business schools for 2021: on-campus MBA programs. Niche.com, 2021 named Radford University among best colleges for criminal justice and best colleges for sports management and DesignIntelligence, 2019 recognized the university for most admired interior design schools.

- provide strategic and operational planning for Advancement and University Relations, developing and managing systems of accountability for staff in all divisional areas, managing budget priorities, and fully integrating the division;
- recruit, train, and develop staff to meet and exceed goals and serve as representatives of the university;
- lead Alumni Relations to develop plans, initiatives, and programs that significantly increase engagement of all alumni through donations of time, talent, and participation in university events and activities; and
- work collaboratively with the President, members of the RU Foundation Board and Board of Visitors, advisory boards, and other leaders and volunteers to identify, cultivate, solicit, and steward donors for priority areas within the university.

LEADERSHIP

Bret Danilowicz, Ph.D. President

Bret Danilowicz, Ph.D. began serving as President of Radford University on July 1, 2022. A strong advocate of shared governance and transparency, Dr. Danilowicz brings 22 years of higher education leadership experience to the presidency. Most recently, he served as Provost and Vice President for Academic Affairs at Florida Atlantic University. As Provost, he implemented incentive-based budgeting, coordinated a

nation-leading improvement in graduation rates, established a public forum for civil discourse, and developed and implemented strategies for advancement towards R1 reclassification.

Before joining Florida Atlantic University, he served as Dean of the College of Arts and Sciences at Oklahoma State University. There, he created a shared governance strategic planning and budgeting process, diversified college and departmental leadership, established a college-wide focus on diversity and inclusion, and always exceeded fundraising goals. While Dean, he co-authored *Organizing Academic Colleges*, which uses models and case studies to describe how to successfully navigate administrative reorganizations.

Previously, he was Associate Dean, then Dean, of the College of Science and Technology at Georgia Southern University. He added engineering programs, thereby disrupting a long-standing state monopoly held by Georgia Tech, greatly expanded undergraduate research opportunities, and initiated the university's nationally recognized sustainability efforts. His administrative journey started as Associate Dean of Science at University College Dublin, Ireland, with a focus on student success.

Dr. Danilowicz attained a B.S. in biology from Utica College of Syracuse University. He went on to earn a Ph.D. in zoology from Duke University, an M.A. in education leadership and management from Open University, and finally an MBA from Georgia Southern University.

- experience leading or supporting capital campaigns;
- experience leading or supporting marketing and communications functions in a higher education environment;
- a team-oriented leadership approach with an ability to inspire and motivate staff and colleagues;
- experience working with governing and advisory boards in a higher education environment;
- knowledge of endowment funds, non-profit financial management, and investment practices; and
- an understanding of brand strategy, creative development process, and agency management.

A bachelor's degree is required for this position. A master's degree, or an equivalent level of training and work experience, is preferred.

Radford University offers a competitive salary and a comprehensive package of Commonwealth of Virginia and agency-specific benefits including health insurance, flexible spending accounts, leave, life insurance, and primary and supplemental retirement plans. Radford University is in Radford, Virginia, 36 miles southwest of Roanoke in the New River Valley, close to the Blue Ridge Mountains of Virginia. In addition to the main campus, Radford University has operations in Roanoke at Radford University Carilion and Roanoke Higher Education Center, as well as in Abingdon at the Southwest Virginia Higher Education Center.
