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# MARK SCHEME

## Extended Hunter Questions

**Marking is somewhat open to interpretation. Marks should be given to reasonably similar ideas and presentation to the examples below, with appropriate evidence. Deduct marks for missing/inaccurate evidence and poor presentation/structure.**

- a) 'Stroke it with a goldfish finger'(1) and 'poke it with a dead wasp's stinger.'(1)
- b) Five days, as the poem states, 'watch the clock 'til you're five days older.'(1)
- c) The recipe tells you to take 'about four ounces' of blood.(1)
- d) We are told to put it in 'a Tesco's bag.'(1)
- e) The film character mentioned is Batman, when it says, 'shred a Batman movie poster.'(1)
- f) Four impossible things in the poem are, 'goldfish finger'(1), 'hair from a shaven snake'(1), 'freeze it with some burning coal'(1) and 'a flying, feathered squid.'(1)
- g) After making this potion, you will find out that it was pointless(1): 'It's been a massive waste of time.'(1)
