



FAUCARIA TIGRINA
“TIGER’S JAW”

IDEAL LIGHT

Full sun to partial shade

WINTER HARDINESS

Not frost tolerant - protect from freezing

PROPAGATION METHODS

Offsets and seeds

WATER NEEDS

Water only when soil is dry

MATURE SIZE

3 inches tall

ADDITIONAL NOTES

“Tiger’s Jaw” has thick, green leaves that have a triangular shape. The “teeth” along its edges are used to collect moisture. If it receives enough light, you can see large yellow flowers during the day in the fall and winter.

The leaves of “Tiger’s Jaw” may seem sharp, but are actually quite soft. They turn a deep purple when given enough sunlight.
