## JOB TITLE: GATE COACH

## JOB FUNCTIONS:

- Assists with the planning, implementation, and evaluation of special student and parent activities
- Works with the Assistant Superintendent of Educational Services and other GATE coaches to develop the GATE manual
- Works with the Assistant Superintendent of Educational Services and other GATE coaches to revise the GATE application
- Works with the Assistant Superintendent of Educational Services and other GATE coaches to prepare a final report to the Board of Education on the progress of the GATE program
- Oversees the GATE budget and coordinates spending
- Holds three (3) to five (5) parent meetings and maintains copies of sign-in sheets, agendas, and minutes
- Identifies GATE students which may include:
  - queries SAT 9 for potential students
  - ensures that Gifted Identification forms are available to staff in the lounge
  - holds informational meetings with staff to identify students
  - meets with counseling to ensure that incoming Cums are scrutinized for prior GATE identification of students
- Follows up with Psychologists to ensure that testing is taking place
