is a double fet-ha

2 of them over a letter for nunation

Kas-ra-taan

is a double kas-ra

2 of them under a letter for nunation

Damma-taa

is double damma

2 of them over a letter for nunation




Tanween or ‘nunation’ is using a double vowel to cause an ‘n’ sound. This nunation does not exist in English however you will understand the significance of it after you begin to learn basic Arabic vocabulary and basic grammar. For now, learn it and know that it will have meaning later on.

Keep on keeping on, you're doing fine!



Read Words with Tan-ween

In the Arabic language, sometimes a noun may take a different ending because of grammar rules. Here are some real words and how they change with tan-ween.

بِنْتًا - بِنْتٍ - بِنْتٌ

bintun / bintin/ bintan



All 3 of these words mean 'girl' but have different endings due to grammar rules.

وَلَدًا - وَلَدٍ - وَلَدٌ

waladun / waladin/ waladan



كُوبًا - كُوبٍ - كُوبٌ

kuubun / kuubin/ kuuban

سَمَاءً - سَمَاءٍ - سَمَاءٌ

Samaa-un / samaa- in / samaa- an
