NOTICE TO PLAYERS

LOCAL RULES: Play is governed by the Rules of Golf as approved by the USGA and The R&A effective January 2019 and the Local Rules and Terms of Competitions for the GAM Championships. In addition, the following Local Rules shall be in effect:

Format: 36-Hole Stroke Play Competition

Tees: Super Senior: GAM Blue Tee Markers
Legends Division GAM Gold Tee Markers

Out of Bounds: Defined by chain link fence and white stakes at ground level. Also, the driving range, maintenance facility and the parking lot behind Hole 9 and Hole 18 are out of bounds and are defined by white stakes. Driveway to the left of Hole #10 is out of bounds. In the absence of stakes, the parking lot and driveway will define out of bounds. A ball which crosses a public road defined as out of bounds and comes to rest beyond that road is out of bounds, even though it may lie on another part of the course.

Ground Under Repair: Defined by freshly painted white lines. On putting greens, depressed and damaged areas are considered ground under repair. Relief is available for lie of ball and line of putt, for a ball that lies on the putting green. Line of play relief from depressed or damaged areas on the green is NOT available for a ball that lies off the putting green.

Red Penalty Area: The red penalty area behind the green of Hole #5 does not extend the length of Hole #6.

Obstructions: Cart path extensions are deemed to be part of the path, and therefore are obstructions.

Distance Measuring Devices: The following Rule applies to players, as well as caddies, in the competition, if a player uses a distance-measuring device that is designed to gauge or measure other conditions that might affect his/her play, AND USES IT FOR THOSE OTHER CONDITIONS the player is in breach of Rule 4. 3a(1) and subject to the general penalty. If the player then continues to use the device, the player is subject to disqualification.

Playoff: In case of a tie for the Championship in either division, a hole-by-hole playoff will begin as soon as all scores are posted.

Pace of Play: Please refer to the local pace of play policy. Keep within 13 minutes of the group ahead of you and you are expected to make a stroke in no more than 40 seconds from when you are able to play without interference or distraction. You should usually be able to play more quickly than that and are encouraged to do so.

Remember:

- The GAM may time all players at any point
- Always play ready golf
- Your position relative to the group in front of you is your responsibility
