Advocacy

A key role of Squash SA is to advocate for the sport on behalf of clubs. This can come in the form of public recognition of achievement, inclusion, government lobbying, liaison with key stakeholders such as Councils, Office for Recreation and Sport, Squash Australia and Sport SA.

What you need to know

Cost of insurance is heavily subsidised by Squash SA to keep affiliation fees minimal for clubs/centres. The annual fee to affiliate with Squash SA is less than \$130.

The period of affiliation is from 1 January to 31 December.

An Affiliation Form must be completed each year so we can keep our databases and website up to date and you can get the most out of your affiliation.

For players to be eligible for insurance, they must be registered to a competition, either via Sporty HQ or an In-house Registration Form.
