PLAYERS CODE OF CONDUCT POLICY

Policy Overview

Squash Australia has implemented a Players Code of Conduct Policy which takes effect immediately.

You will need to review the Players Code of Conduct Policy and make yourself familiar with the contents of the policy.

What is a Players Code of Conduct Policy?

The Players Code of Conduct Policy sets out the expectations of Squash Australia with regards to all players.

Some important points to consider

The Players Code of Conduct Policy sets out clear guidelines and boundaries regarding the standards of performance and behavior to ensure that players act in a professional and proper manner and to ensure that the sport is played and conducted with disciplined and sporting behaviour.

What do I need to do?

You need to read the Players Code of Conduct Policy carefully and understand the expectations of Squash Australia.

OBJECT OF THIS CODE

Squash Australia is committed to promoting and strengthening the positive image of the game of squash in Australia.

In light of this commitment, the Code of Conduct seeks to establish standards of performance and behavior to ensure that players act in a professional and proper manner and to ensure that the sport is played and conducted with disciplined and sporting behaviour. The Code of Conduct also seeks to deter all conduct that could damage the game of Squash by impairing public confidence in the honest and orderly management of the game conduct of competitions or in the integrity and good character of the players. In addition, this Players Code of Conduct seeks to ensure that every player is liable to effective sanctions if they are found to have breached the Code of Conduct.

A squash player is entitled to have his or her privacy including that of their family and friends respected and the Code is not intended to apply to activities engaged in by a player of a private nature, which may include activities with family, friends and/or other

squash players.

In addition to Squash Australia's General Code of Conduct, you must meet the following requirements in regard to your conduct during any activity held by or under the auspices of Squash Australia in your role as a player.

PLAYERS CODE OF CONDUCT

1. Respect the rights, dignity and worth of fellow players, coaches, officials and spectators;
2. Refrain from conduct which could be regarded as sexual or other harassment;
3. Respect the talent, potential and development of fellow players and competitors;
4. Care and respect the uniform and equipment provided to you;
5. Be frank and honest with your coach concerning illness and injury and your ability to train and play to your full capacity;
6. Conduct yourself in a responsible manner relating to language, temper and punctuality;
7. Maintain a high standard of personal behaviour at all times;
8. Abide by the rules and respect the decision of the officials. Be courteous and use the correct process when seeking a rule clarification;
9. Be honest in your attitude and preparation to training. Work equally hard for yourself, coach and other players;
10. Co-operate with coaches and staff in relation to programs that adequately prepare you for competition;
11. Do not engage in practices that affect sporting performance (alcohol, tobacco and drug use);
12. Adhere to the Squash Australia media/social media policy.
