Grab your balls to go—the sandwich versions are especially well-suited for this—beginning with dinner opening week and then lunch and late night starting July 21st. They'll also have another first at the new locale: an ice cream cart that'll dish out the shop's house-made ice cream sandwiches like Lemon Fro-Yo and Sour Cherry Lambic with Dark Chocolate Fudge and Hazelnut Snickerdoodle cookies.
