




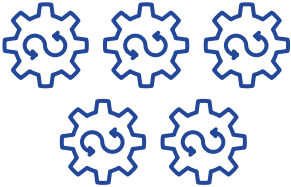

FROM CHANGE TO TRANSFORMATION
