Always | 90% - 100% frequency

- I always get up before noon.
- She always has coffee in the morning.

Usually / Normally | 70% - 90% frequency

- I usually drive to work.
- We normally watch TV at home.

Often | 40% - 70% frequency

- I often eat at my desk.
- She often plays tennis on the weekend.

Sometimes / Occasionally | 10% - 40% frequency

- I sometimes drive my mom to work.
- They sometimes come over for dinner.

Rarely / Seldom | 0% - 10% frequency

- Most people rarely wear a tuxedo.
- She rarely uses any social media.

Never | 0% frequency

- I never drink beer at work.
- Most people never leave their country.
