Always | 90% - 100% frequency

- I **always** get up before noon.
- She **always** has coffee in the morning.

Usually / Normally | 70% - 90% frequency

- I **usually** drive to work.
- We **normally** watch TV at home.

Often | 40% - 70% frequency

- I **often** eat at my desk.
- She **often** plays tennis on the weekend.

Sometimes / Occasionally | 10% - 40% frequency

- I **sometimes** drive my mom to work.
- They **sometimes** come over for dinner.

Rarely / Seldom | 0% - 10% frequency

- Most people **rarely** wear a tuxedo.
- She **rarely** uses any social media.

Never | 0% frequency

- I **never** drink beer at work.
- Most people **never** leave their country.
