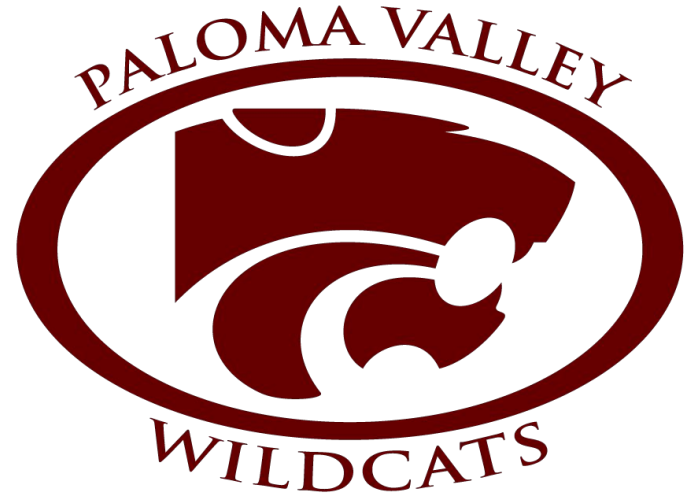

The AVID Program consists of G- Elective courses at the 9th -12th grades. Students in the AVID program have the opportunity to visit various college campuses over the course of four years including local colleges, an overnight stay in Los Angeles and a 4-5 day Northern California trip.

In addition to college visits, students in the AVID Program have access to many college and career speakers and participate in leadership and college cultural events.

Furthermore, students in the AVID Program receive mentoring from current college students and become self advocates for higher learning.
