

SEDUM CLAVATUM

IDEAL LIGHT

Full sun to partial shade

WINTER HARDINESS

Not cold hardy

PROPAGATION METHODS

Cuttings, leaves, seed

WATER NEEDS

Water only when soil is dry

MATURE SIZE

6 inches tall | 8 inches wide

ADDITIONAL NOTES

Sedum clavatum makes excellent ground cover, as it spreads and trails, and works well in hanging baskets. Watch for small white flowers to bloom in the summer.

When Sedum clavatum's blueish-green leaves are stressed, the tips turn a beautiful light pink. For this reason, it's best to grow it outdoors. If grown inside, it tends not to thrive and will lose its color.
