

## 2nd GAM Net Stableford

#### **NOTICE TO PLAYERS**

LOCAL RULES: Play is governed by the Rules of Golf as approved by the USGA and The R&A effective January 2019 and the Local Rules and Terms of Competitions for the GAM Championships. In addition, the following Local Rules shall be in effect:

Format: 18-Hole Stableford Competition

Tees:

Men's Division: GAM Gold Tee Markers Senior Men's Division: GAM Blue Tee Markers Women's Division: GAM Silver Tee Markers

<u>Stableford Format:</u> A player's score for a hole is based on points awarded by comparing the player's number of strokes (including strokes made and penalty strokes) on the hole to a fixed target score for the hole set by the Committee. In this competition, the fixed score will be net par for each individual. Please mark gross scores only in Golf Genius. You may pick up and mark net double bogey if it is certain you will make 2 or more over net par for a hole.

## **GAM Net Stableford Points System**

4 Under Net Par: 12 Points 3 Under Net Par: 8 Points 2 Under Net Par: 5 Points 1 Under Net Par: 2 Points Net Par: 0 Points

1 Over Net Par: -1 Points 2+ Over Net Par: -3 Points

<u>Out of Bounds</u>: Defined by white stakes and perimeter fencing. A ball that crosses Bellevue Rd and comes to rest beyond that road is deemed to be out of bounds, even though it may lie on another part of the course. If white stakes are not present, the inside edge of Bellevue Rd. defines out of bounds on Hole #5 and Hole #9. The inside edge of the curb behind No. 2 putting green defines out of bounds until white stakes come back in to play..

<u>Ground Under Repair</u>: All freshly painted white lined areas. French drains are deemed to be ground under repair. Newly laid sod is considered ground under repair and a No Play Zone for lie of ball only; relief is mandatory and there is no penalty. All flower beds are considered ground under repair and No Play Zones; relief is mandatory and there is no penalty.

Immovable Obstructions: Extended worn out areas will be considered part of the cart path. The pump house and adjacent machinery on Hole #13 is considered an immovable obstruction. The drop zone may be used for relief from the immovable obstruction ONLY. It is not to be used for penalty area relief.

Red Penalty Area: A shot from Hole #10 that enters the yellow penalty area on Hole #13 is considered to have entered a red penalty area.

<u>Distance Measuring Devices</u>: The following Rule applies to players, as well as caddies, in the competition, if a player uses a distance-measuring device that is designed to gauge or measure other conditions that might affect his/her play, AND USES IT FOR THOSE OTHER CONDITIONS the player is in breach of Rule 4. 3a(1) and subject to the general penalty. If the player then continues to use the device, the player is subject to disqualification.

<u>Playoffs:</u> In case of a tie for the Overall Championship, a three-hole aggregate Stableford playoff will begin immediately after all scores are posted. Ties for prizes within Divisions will be decided by the USGA Tiebreaker Method.

Pace of Play: Please refer to the local pace of play policy. Keep within 13 minutes of the group ahead of you and you are expected to make a stroke in no more that 40 seconds from when you are able to play without interference or distraction. When it is your turn to play and there is no interference and distraction, time spent gathering distance and assessing other conditions counts towards your time allotted to play a stroke. You should usually be able to play more quickly than that and are encouraged to do so.

#### Remember:

- The GAM may time all players at any point
- Always play ready golf
- Your position relative to the group in front of you is your responsibility
