



DISOCACTUS FLAGELLIFORMIS
“RAT-TAIL CACTUS”

IDEAL LIGHT

Prefers full sun but can tolerate shade and indoor growing.

WINTER HARDINESS

Not frost tolerant - protect from freezing

PROPAGATION METHODS

Cuttings or seed

WATER NEEDS

Water only when soil is dry

MATURE SIZE

3 feet tall | 1 inch wide

ADDITIONAL NOTES

This tall, trailing cactus is one of the most widely cultivated cacti in its genus. Its thick stems grow tall before the weight of the stems causes it to bend and either hang out of its pot, or trail along the ground.

It typically produces purple-red flowers, although sometimes growers have reported pink or orange blossoms.
