Fellowship Description:

Island Press is pleased to offer a post graduate fellowship to an alumnus of the Sam Fox School.

The Post-Graduate Fellow works in the print shop at Island Press on the Danforth campus at Washington University. They serve as an assistant printer, helping with production and all aspects of management of artist projects, including inventory, marketing, and communications. Fellows work under the supervision of Island Press staff including director, Lisa Bulawsky, master printer, Tom Reed, and assistant printer, Erin Johnston. This is a one year appointment with the possibility to renew for a second year. The fellowship requires 10-15 hours per week. Hourly rate: \$25 per hour.

This fellowship is open to BA, BFA, and MFA graduates of the Sam Fox School of Design & Visual Arts.
