



REGULATION – COACHING **(Recommended for approval 14 February 2010)**

This document is a statement of Squash Tasmania's Policy regarding the development, promotion and employment of squash coaches within Tasmania.

Squash Tasmania supports the Professional Squash Coaches Association of Australia (PSCAA) and recognises that all members of the PSCAA are qualified under the National Coaching Accreditation Scheme, are committed to updating their qualifications and are fully insured.

Members of the PSCAA will be used for all official coaching positions and for Squash Tasmania programs requiring coaching.

All coaches appointed must comply with Squash Tasmania's Member Protection Policy.

The following guidelines will be used when selecting a coach for an official position.

| Type of Program | Minimum Desirable Qualification |
|---|---------------------------------|
| Club Coaching Programs | NCAS Level 1 |
| Regional Training Camps | NCAS Level 2 |
| State Training Camps | NCAS Level 2 |
| State Team Coach | NCAS Level 2 or higher |
| Squash-in-Schools and Squash-in-Centre Programs | NCAS Level 1 |
| Totball Programs | Totball Trainers Certificate |
