

Teacher Lab Online Course - Grading

Participants must earn an overall **Pass** grade for their coursework in order to receive either 12 CTLE credits or 1 P-credit (also receives 12 CTLE credits).

In order to earn an overall **Pass** grade for their coursework, participants must earn a **Pass** grade for course participation <u>and</u> a **Pass** grade for their final assignment. Grades will be issued according to the grading rubrics.

Receiving a **Fail** grade for either component will result in receiving an overall **Fail** grade for the course. Participants may re-attempt to earn a **Pass** grade for either component as many times as needed. Grading for the course will be issued according to the following scale:

Participation: Exit Ticket completion = 20% Participation: Posting to discussion board = 20%

Final Assignment = 60%
