#### **Appendix II-The Racket**

- Hitting surface
  - Stringing pattern be generally uniform
  - Playing characteristics are identical
  - Free of attached objects
- Frame of the racket
- Free of any device
  - No energy source



### **Appendix III-Advertising**

- Permitted on the net
- Interferes with the vision of the players
- Court surface
- Colouring of advertising
- Inside the lines of the court



#### Appendix IV-Alternative scoring methods

- No-Ad scoring method
  - Deuce receiver chooses the side
  - Doubles not change position
  - Mixed Doubles Same gender
- Short Sets
- Deciding Match Tie-Break (7/10 points)
- Deciding Match Tie-Break
  - Order of service continues
  - Doubles
  - 120 seconds break
- ITF Coaching

- Balls should not be changed

- Player may not cross net to check ball mark
