



SENECIO BARBERTONICUS
“SUCCULENT BUSH SENECIO”

IDEAL LIGHT

Full sun to partial shade

WINTER HARDINESS

Not frost tolerant - protect from freezing

PROPAGATION METHODS

Cuttings

WATER NEEDS

Water only when soil is dry

MATURE SIZE

5 feet tall | 5 feet wide

ADDITIONAL NOTES

This evergreen succulent “bush” adds a lot of texture to your outdoor succulent garden. The leaves are light green, pointing up on the branching stems. Watch for yellow flowers in the Spring.

Because “Succulent Bush” grows so tall, it can get heavy and could topple over. When it does, behead the top until the stem is firm again. You can then propagate the cuttings.
