But not all boozy desserts are created equal: Some have a barely detectable taste of liqueur, while others offer a full-on 3-ounce pour of the hard stuff. Here are three recommendations for drinkers of every disposition — and where you can get your hands on them.

Beginner

Wine has its place among sweets. At **Il Laboratorio del Gelato** (188 Ludlow St., www.laboratoriodelgelato.com), for a limited time, you can try the Ruffino Prosecco Gelato with Clementine. You can even take it home with you in a 20-ounce container for \$10.50. A faint bubbly essence lets you savor the wine amid the other delicate flavors of this fruity sorbet.

Moderate

GO Burger (1448 Second Ave., www.goburger.com) lists several milkshakes on its menu — three contain alcohol. The **Night Rider** is our favorite, with Kahlua, chocolate liqueur, chocolate ice cream and Oreos. There's also **The All Nighter**, if you need a caffeine jolt.



Champion

Yes, you already know about the ever-popular **Meatball Shop**. But you're probably overlooking its best treat: the **Whiskey Float**. You choose the whiskey, and you can really taste the liquor; yet the vanilla still comes through.
