

# *Sukoon*

السكون



The **sukoon** over a letter means that the letter does not move as do the letters which have fe-tha, kas-ra, or damma. We stop the harf (letter) at its place (makh-raj) without giving it a vowel at all. The sukoon appears over the letter in one of 2 ways:

- As a circle “o”
- As a symbol that looks like this “>” in the Quran


