In the last pre-class video you chose and downloaded a set of color swatches that will be unique to your scrapbook page for this class. In this video, we'll replace the default swatches here in Photoshop with the ones we'll be using for the remainder of this class. To replace the color swatches, you'll need the Color Swatches panel. To get that in the Menu

Bar, choose window swatches. If the Swatches panel does not automatically dock with the Layers panel, you can click and drag it to the Layers panel so that the entire Layers panel has a blue line around it, and then when you let go, there'll be docked together. Then to replace the swatches, in the Swatches panel, open the dropdown menu and choose replaced swatches. A dialog box will open, asking you to navigate to the Swatches file that you'd like to open. Mine is in my downloads folder. I'll click on it and then click open. Now your new swatches are ready to use for the remainder of this class. This is Jen White with Digital Scrapbooking Mastery.
